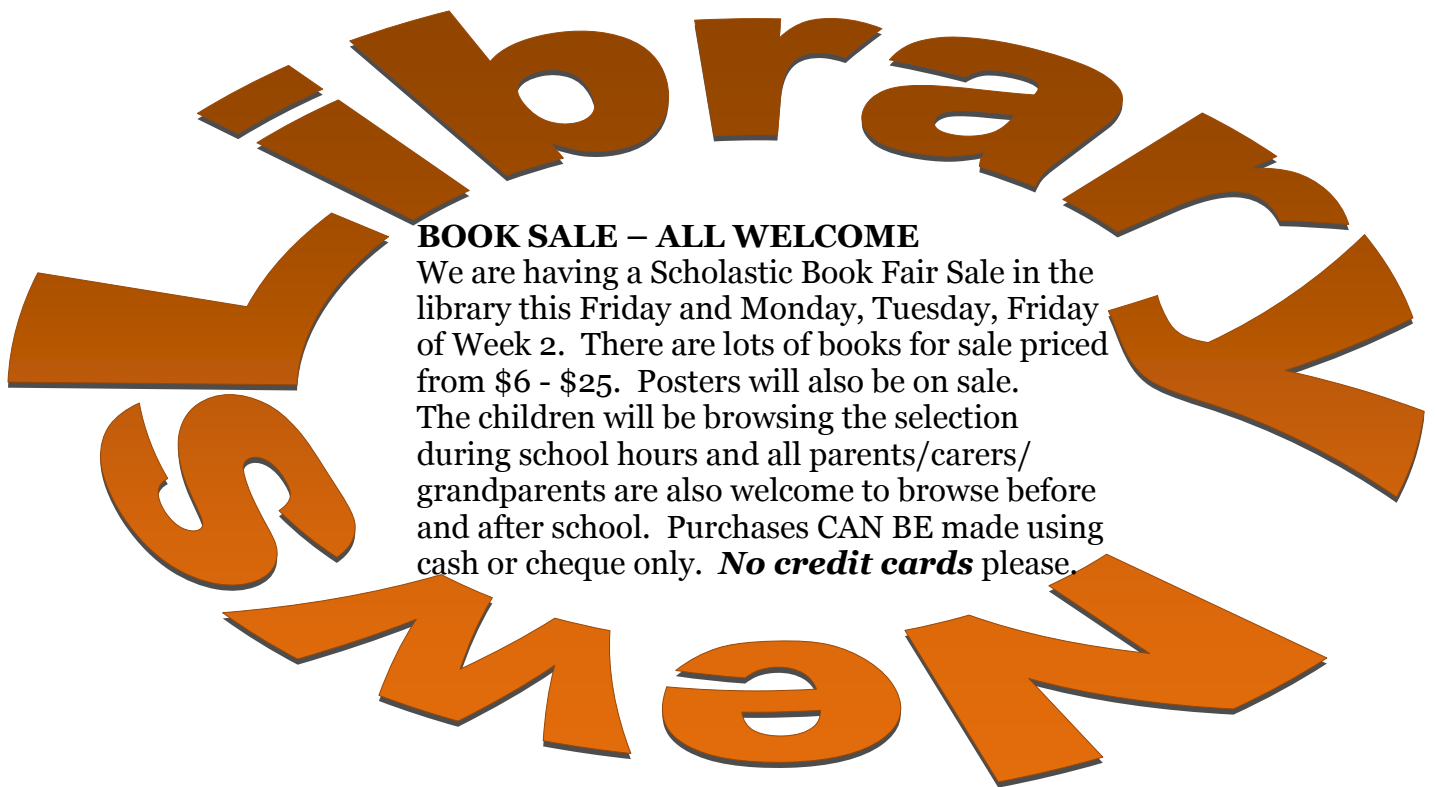
Athletics Carnival
