



1 PINK









In Science this term, I Pink have been learning about how weather changes throughout the day and across the seasons, and how these changes affect our daily lives. The class also explored different symbols that represent each


season.



I Pink have also been learning about the night sky, including star patterns and the changing shape of the moon. The students explored constellations named after mythological figures, animals, and objects, and even created their own constellation artworks.



In English, the students in I Pink have been exploring how we connect meanings to different things. We read the book 'The Black Book of Colours', and then used our five senses to describe a colour of our choice.



Pink looks like bright lipstick and Mr.Barton.
Pink feels like a warm blanket and love.
Pink sounds like confetti bursting in to the sky and glitter
strawberry milks hakes and dragon fruit
Pink smells like flowers and cotton condu and perfume.

Then, in groups, students shared information about a colour using Auslan Sign Language, braille, speech and visual representations, including a collage.













3/4 ORANGE

The children enjoyed and discussed all the poems in the unit, giving their own reasons for preferences. The looked at the language, grammar and style of poetry and gained a sense of voice when writing their own. Creating their own poetry inspired creativity and rhythm. The children were introduced to new words and used adjectives, alliteration, similes found synonyms, used imagery and onomatopoeia to create their poetry.

They drafted whole-class poems, evaluating and editing as they went. Further composition work included drafting and writing an Acrostic poem and a Cinquain poem. They also prepared poems to read aloud.

Lewis enjoyed how we explored different types of poetry and how each poem was set out.

Ali enjoyed doing the ACROSTIC poem about friendships. If you read out the first letter it will give out the theme of the poem vertically.





CANCELLATIONS

Some late cancellations/absences may incur a fee as we purchase resources in advance and roster our staff based on booking numbers:
